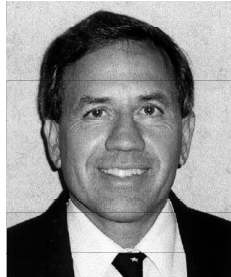

Message from the President...

FINALLY ROE V. WADE IS OVERTURNED!!! by Robert Kettering

On Friday, June 24th it finally happened, after 49 years the Supreme Court overturned Roe v. Wade holding that there is no longer a right to abortion. Going forward, abortion “rights” will be determined by each state. Already nearly half of the states have or will pass laws that ban abortion while others have enacted measures that regulate the procedure.

The opinion represents the culmination of a decades long effort by millions of Americans who opposed abortion and the 1973 decision that made it legal. The vote was 5-3-1 (Chief Justice John Roberts did not join the majority, writing in a concurring opinion that he would not have overturned Roe but instead would have only upheld Mississippi's law banning abortions after 15 weeks) The ruling was made possible by a conservative majority including three of Donald Trumps nominees.

“Roe was egregiously wrong from the start,” Justice Samuel Alito wrote in his majority opinion, “It's reasoning was exceptionally weak, and the decision has had damaging consequences. And far from bringing about a national settlement of the abortion issue. Roe and Casey have inflamed debate and deepened division.”

Former Vice President Mike Pence praised the ruling saying “the high court has given the American People a new beginning for life” and commended the justices in the majority for “having the courage of their convictions” “Now that Roe v. Wade has been consigned to the ash heap of history, a new arena in the cause of life has emerged and it is incumbent on all who cherish the sanctity of life to resolve that we will take the defense of the unborn and the support for women in crisis pregnancy centers to every state in America.”

Isn't it amazing that right in the middle of the Biden/Harris presidency, the most pro-abortion, anti-life administration that America has ever seen, Roe v. Wade is overturned! Praise the Lord for this decision and this awesome victory! He is faithful!!!

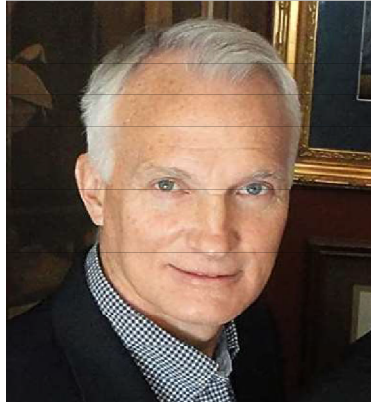

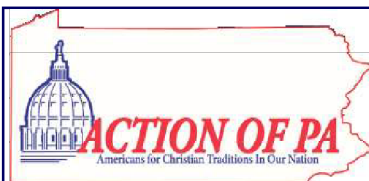
