October Breakfast Will Feature Governor Tom Corbett

Plan now to attend the next ACTION Breakfast scheduled for Saturday, October 11th at 8:00am at the Enck's Catering Facility (formerly Kreider's Restaurant) located at 1455 Lancaster Road (Rt 72) in Manheim. Our guest speaker will be Governor Tom Corbett. Governor Corbett will be facing democrat Tom Wolf this November. On the social issues, Governor Corbett and Tom Wolf could not be further apart. On the life issue, Governor Corbett has been a solid supporter of life, while Tom Wolf is pro-abortion, supports taxpayer funding of abortion and even taxpayer funding of gender re-assignment surgery for state employees. We are delighted and honored to have the Governor for our October quarterly breakfast. We hope that you will be able to join us for this special event.

Since his inauguration as Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on January 18th, 2011, Tom Corbett has been fighting for the people of PA. By reducing spending for the first time in 40 years, cutting government waste and fraud, balancing state budgets without borrowing more or raising taxes on the middle class and opening up the Marcellus Shale for responsible exploration and development, PA was able to close a \$4.2 billion budget deficit, invest unprecedented funding in public education, create over 150,000 new private sector jobs and is on the verge of unchartered economic prosperity. Tom Corbett has dedicated much of his life to serving others. After graduating from college, Tom spent a year as a civics and history teacher at Pine Grove Area High School in Schuylkill County. A few years after graduating from law school, Tom was hired by the Reagan administration as an Assistant U.S. Attorney for the Western District of PA, focusing on organized crime and drug enforcement. He was also one of the first members of President Reagan's National Drug Task Force. In 1989, following several years of private law practice, he was appointed as the United States Attorney for Western PA by President George H.W. Bush.

A lifelong Pennsylvanian, Tom was born in Philadelphia and raised in Shaler Township outside of Pittsburgh, where he attended high school. He obtained his undergraduate degree from Lebanon Valley College in Annville, PA and his law degree from St. Mary's U. School of Law in San Antonio, Texas. Tom also served his country and Commonwealth for 13 years as a member of the PA National Guard's 28th Infantry Division, before retiring as a Captain in 1984.

Tom Corbett and Susan Manbeck of Pine Grove, PA were married in 1972. They continue to reside in Shaler Township in the same home in which Tom grew up and have been blessed with two children, Tom and Katherine, and a grandson, Liam.


Issue	Tom Wolf (D)	Gov. Tom Corbett (R)
Abortion	Strongly pro-choice and would oppose any legislation that places "unnecessary restrictions" on abortion. Promised to rescind any restrictions on abortion made by Corbett.	PA is one of the Top 5 "Most Protective States for Life" by Americans United for Life under Gov. Corbett's leadership. 
